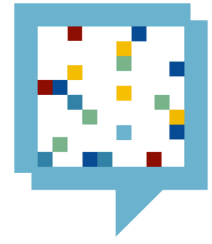


# Francisco LUPIÁÑEZ-VILLANUEVA
