Vaia Doudaki works as an Assistant Professor of Media Studies in the Institute of Communication Studies and Journalism at Charles University in Prague.

Prior to joining Charles University, she worked as Lecturer and Assistant Professor at the Cyprus University of Technology, and as Associate Professor at Uppsala University in Sweden. Her theoretical and research activity lies at the intersection of journalism studies, discourse studies and alternative media studies. Her work is driven by social constructionist and post-structuralist approaches, focussing on the study of representations, discursive practices, and the social construction of identities and social phenomena, in media and communication.

Her fields of study include media, conflict and crisis (economic crisis, ethnic clashes, societal conflicts, migration, poverty and social exclusion); discourses of legitimation; alternative, community and participatory media; civil society, activism and communication; theory and practice of news-making and journalism; journalistic identities and practices in the internet era. Her latest monograph is 'Discourses of Legitimation in the News' (Routledge, 2020), co-authored with Angeliki Boubouka.

Within EUMEPLAT, she coordinates the Institute's work on Work Package 2 ("Fake News: Platformization of Journalism") and 4 ("Exclusion: Platformization of Media Representations").
